

**SOLICITATION OF PUBLIC COMMENTS AND

TO AMEND THE MARICOPA URBAN COUNTY
FY 2008-2009 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

Maricopa County is in the process of amending the **Maricopa Urban County FY 2008-2009 Annual Action Plan (AAP)**. The Maricopa County Human Services Department is seeking citizen input and comment on a draft amendment to the FY2008 AAP to direct \$1,000,000 in program income derived from the Neighborhood Stabilization Program funds to the Purchase & Rehabilitation – Single and/or Multi-Family Rental activity.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Maricopa County Human Services Department, Community Development Division, will hold a Public Hearing on the proposed amendment to the FY2008 Maricopa Urban County AAP on Wednesday, January 12, 2011, beginning at 6:30 p.m., in the Arizona Conference Room, Third Floor, 234 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, Arizona.
