Performance Measure

	Baseline	Target
Incorporate MCDOT roadways with a V/C ratio ≥ 1.0 into the long-range TIP	26%	30%
Incorporate MCDOT roadways within the PM-10 area exceeding 100 vpd into the long-range TIP	13%	15%
*Complete centerline miles of bike lanes	0	25 miles
*Complete centerline miles of sidewalk	0	25 miles
Bring curb ramps into compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act	$\geq 1\%$	50%
Actively monitor and adjust signal timing to optimize travel times on MCDOT's arterial corridors	70%	80%

*The performance measure intent is to track the construction of the new facilities over a 5-year period starting in 2020.
