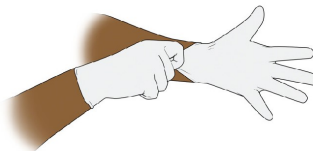


How to:

Sanitize with Bleach

1

Put on disposable gloves.



2

Clean up vomit and stool (poop) with paper towels.

Use kitty litter, baking soda, or other absorbent material on carpets and upholstery to absorb liquid; do not vacuum material.



3

Wash surfaces that contacted vomit or diarrhea and all nearby high-touch surfaces, such as door knobs and toilet handles, with soapy water.

Rinse with plain water and dry with paper towels.



4

Apply a 1:10 bleach solution (1 part bleach to 9 parts water) to surfaces and allow it to air dry.

Rinse all surfaces intended for food or mouth contact with plain water before use.



5

Dispose of soiled paper towels and gloves in a plastic trash bag and place in garbage.



6

Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water.

Hand sanitizers may not be effective against all germs.
